Multi-factor Authentication

Multi-factor Authentication enhances your account security by requiring a code that is sent to your email address or your personal mobile phone whenever you are logging in from an unrecognized device.

When you successfully login with your username and password you are prompted to enter a Multi-factor Authentication code from a method of your choosing (text or email). Once you have collected the code that was sent to you within 10 minutes of requesting it, have it successfully entered on the continued login page, the login process is complete.

Open both the D.A. Davidson's Client Access page and your email using the tabs on the top of your browser.
